JOIN US FOR A FUN-FILLED DAY AT COOLIDGE STATE PARK, PLYMOUTH, VT

A trip to Coolidge State Park is a trip back in time. The park was created in the 1930s and remains essentially the same. Known for its rustic feel, hillside campsites, dramatic mountain views, and authentic character, the park is the centerpiece of the 21,500 acre Calvin Coolidge State Forest, the largest state-owned land holding in central Vermont. The park has a loop of forested campsites, restroom facilities with coin-op showers, and hilltop picnic area with a log picnic shelter. Within the park, there are miles of hiking trails to explore and streams to cross. Some visitors are lucky enough to catch a glimpse of a barred owl, a moose, or a black bear.

ACTIVITIES FOR THE DAY INCLUDE:

Hiking options for A, B and C hikers. The “A hike” is a 3 hour, 5 - 6 mile hike and includes an initial 1 mile of steep, steady uphill. The “B hike” is a 2 hour, 3.5 mile hike with moderate ups and downs. The “C hike” is a 1 ½ - 2 hour, 2 – 2 ½ mile hike with easy to moderate ups and downs. All hikes will cross a scenic vista lookout.

For non-hikers, the Plymouth Notch Antique Apple Festival runs from 10 – 4 at the Calvin Coolidge Homestead. The festival is a celebration of the harvest, with special attention to the apple! Activities for the entire family: apple recipe competition, cider pressing, wagon rides, historic farm & craft demonstrations, barbecue & harvest treats, and cheese making at the Plymouth Cheese Factory. <http://historicsites.vermont.gov/taxonomy/term/646>

Apres hike party at the Pavilion with lawn games and Coolidge trivia. BYOB, chair, snacks and something to share.

Dinner at 5 pm, sharp, in the Pavilion. Hamburgers, hotdogs, cheeseburgers, veggie burgers and salmon burgers. Hot and cold side dishes and salads. BYOB and/or soft drinks.

Dessert & Joe’s “Cool Calvin Coolidge Cool as a Cucumber Mint Cocktail” at the lodge.

Cost is \$35 and covers pavilion rental, park admission (you will need your MTL membership card), dinner, dessert and Joe’s theme cocktail.
