The Skiers Unlimited adaptive ski program is designed for children ages 6 to 18 years old with special needs. This instructional ski program gives your child the opportunity to share an exhilarating winter sports activity with other children of similar abilities. The Connecticut Children's Medical Center and the Hospital for Special Care partner with Mt Southington, Alpine Haus of Wethersfield, Newington Ski Club and highly trained volunteers to create a fun and exciting learning experience..

#### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:**

- To provide an opportunity for the child to participate in a winter recreational activity
- For the child to increase his sense of task mastery and improve self esteem
- To provide for continued socialization with peers while engaged in physical activity
- To provide for normalized activity while promoting the "can-do" attitude
- To notify the family of other recreational resources available for the Physically Challenged
- A community outreach connection to Connecticut Children's Medical Center

There is no cost to the families for participation in the Skiers Unlimited program. Provided to all participants are the skis, ski boots, ski helmets, all adaptive equipment needed, Mt Southington ski passes and ski instructions. The ski equipment is professionally fit to each child at the Alpine Haus in Wethersfield, CT in December.
